100's Brave Worst Shabbos Morning Storms in Years to Begin Shabbos Building Block Discussion

Torrential downpours failed to keep 100's away from shul last Shabbos as Rabbi Ilan and Miriam Feldman introduced the latest Building Block of Community—Shabbos. Thunder and lightning provided the backdrop for Rabbi Feldman's drasha, delivered in four venues. In his drasha, he described a vision for a Shabbos where people create Shabbos in a new way each week, look forward to it all week, and live off it the following week. After kiddush, well over 200 people stayed in shul to participate in sessions opening up a month long community-wide discussion of important aspects of Shabbos.

Participants were provided exercises designed to practice these main points which emerged during the sessions:

1. Shabbos can be the product of creative, proactive investment which nourishes physically and spiritually (which comes from being in the world of Avodas Hashem, the world of creativity), or it can be an imposed interruption to the week (which occurs when a person is in the world of slavery). It's our choice (**see display in the lobby**).
2. Shabbos is a 7 day affair; the way we live during the week and the focus we have will determine the kind of Shabbos we have.
3. The key to Shabbos is preparation, particularly in the attitude we bring to the preparation and the way we go about it.
